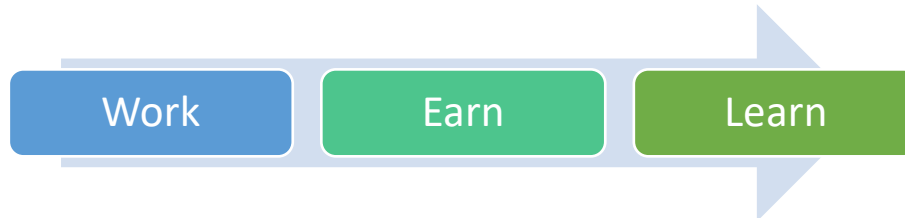


Greenwich Direct Apprenticeship



Start your career with an apprenticeship based in Royal Borough of Greenwich Council. Undertaking an apprenticeship means you'll have on-going learning and development with prospects for future progression. Royal Borough of Greenwich offers a range of apprenticeships across many sectors, including a variety of business administration apprenticeships.

The first stage to applying for these roles is to register your interest with us. If you meet all the requirements for an apprenticeship, you will then be invited to join our talent pool, giving you access to or apprenticeship roles. Once you are confirmed into the talent pool, you will have access to apply to apprentice opportunities as they arise across the organisation.



Why choose an apprenticeship with Royal Greenwich?

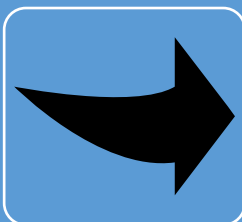
Apprenticeships provide the opportunity to gain vocational qualifications, whilst gaining valuable workplace skills and experience. Successful candidates will secure a fixed term contract in the council on a highly competitive apprenticeship salary.

Roles are 35 hours per week (including training) and on successful completion you will receive a nationally recognised apprenticeship (you will have study release for this).

Who can apply?

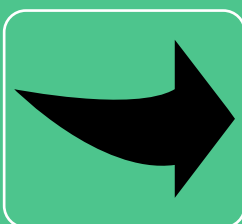
To be eligible to apply for apprenticeships at Royal Greenwich you must:

Have the right to Work in th UK



- And have been a resident in the UK for at least the previous three years before the start of the apprenticeship
- Please note, Government funding is required to complete the apprenticeship qualification. If you have been granted leave to remain status, this must cover the entire duration of the contract to be eligible for funding and for your application to move to the next stage.
- The duration of the contract is typically 18 months but could be longer. This will be clarified in each apprenticeship advert that you may eventually apply for once you have been accepted into the talent pool.

Be a Resident of Royal Greenwich



- Proof of residency will be requested

If living outside of Royal Greenwich ...



- you will still be eligible to apply if you are in the care of Royal Greenwich as defined below:
 - Children 16 to 18 years who are looked after and have been for more than 13 weeks (which does not need to be all one period); AND
 - Care leavers, who can be young people aged between 16 and 24 years (to 25th birthday) who were looked after by Children's Services for a period of 13 weeks or more since the age of 14 (which does not need to be all one period) but must include a time after the 16th birthday.

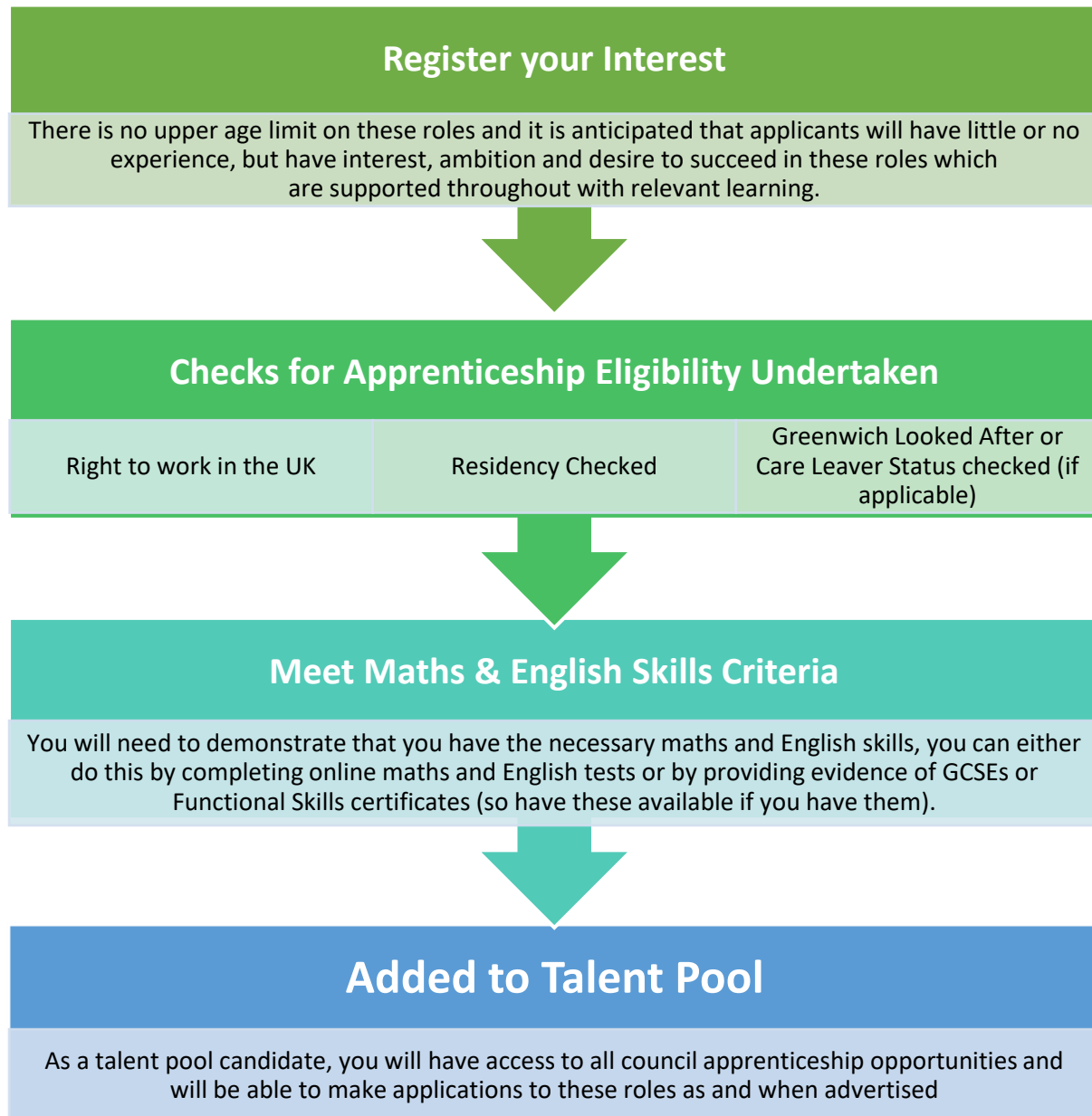
